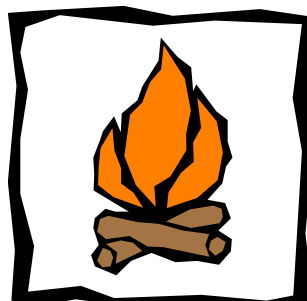

Given the current office closure due to Covid-19, please call 705-246-2472 to request a burning permit or email: admin@hiltontownship.ca We will be happy to email or mail you your permit or arrange for alternate pickup arrangements.

A reminder that burning brush is only permitted within the period of two hours before sunset and two hours after sunrise.
