THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HILTON BY-LAW NO. 1025-11

Being a Zoning By-law for the Township of Hilton.

WHEREAS Section 34 of the Planning Act provides that zoning by-laws may be passed by the Councils of local municipalities, and specifies the matters that a zoning by-law may regulate;

AND WHEREAS zoning by-laws may regulate the use of land, the erection, location and use of buildings and structures, and the provision and maintenance of loading and parking facilities;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed in the public interest to enact a by-law to regulate the use of land, the erection, location and use of buildings and structures, and the provision and maintenance of off-street loading and parking facilities;

AND WHEREAS in the opinion of Council sufficient information and material has been made available to enable the public to understand generally the proposed zoning bylaw;

AND WHEREAS a public meeting has been held for the purpose of giving the public an opportunity to make representations in respect of the proposed by-law;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Hilton hereby enacts the following sections:

- 1. Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9.
- 2. Map Schedule "C".

This by-law repeals By-law No. 401.
