




Winter Parking By-law 1452-25


Reminder that from November 1st to April 30th there is no parking on any municipal road allowance in the Township of Hilton. Full By-law can be found on the website.

Landfill Update

Starting January 2026, the process for paying tipping fees will be changing. All users will be required to purchase "tipping slips" **PRIOR** to visiting the landfill. Tipping slips will be available for purchase at the Village & Township Municipal Offices and the Hilton Beach General Store. Please note that cash will no longer be accepted at the landfill. Hilton Union Fire Department Safety Reminders

- Ensure your chimneys and vents are inspected by a licensed professional, clean and in good working condition.
- Keep all flammable items safely away from heat sources.
- Dispose of ashes carefully and properly in a metal container with a tight-fitting lid.
- New Requirement: As of January 1, 2026, the Ontario Fire Code requires carbon monoxide (CO) alarms on every storey of your home.
- Stay safe and protect your home this winter season!
