2026 Final Tax Bill

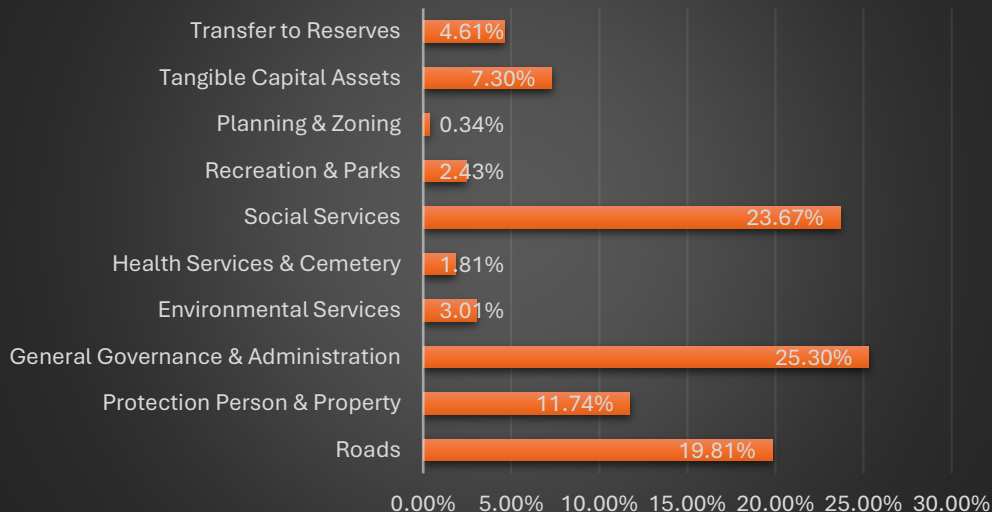
The 2026 Final Tax Bills will be sent out the last week of August with a due date of Wednesday, September 30, 2026.

Payments can be made using the **online** option through your banking institution, **e-transfer** to admin@hiltontownship.ca, or by **cheque**. Please reference your 19-digit Roll Number on all payment methods, as outlined on the bottom of your tax bill.

Please allow 2 to 5 business days for payment processing time.

Parks Updates:

Due to safety concerns and risk management considerations, the playground equipment at Big Point Park has been removed to ensure public safety. A request has been submitted to the MNR for permission to install a tetherball at the park.

Following an inspection at Twin Lakes Park, play structures that did not meet the current safety standards were removed. Plans are underway to repair and/or replace the remaining equipment to ensure public safety and enjoyment.

Fire Ban Status

- Before lighting any outdoor fire, check whether a fire ban is currently in effect within the Township of Hilton or the Village of Hilton Beach. Fire ban notices are posted on the respective websites and on the sign outside the Municipal Office.

Burn Safely

- Weather and environmental conditions can change quickly. When burning outdoors remember to never leave a fire unattended, keep a suitable means of extinguishment nearby (such as a hose or fire extinguisher) and ensure the fire is completely extinguished before leaving the area.
