

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HILTON

BY-LAW NO. 1522-26

Being a by-law to close, stop-up and sell the original
Shore Road Allowance in front of Lot 12, Concession Z,
also being in front of Lot 28, municipally known as 4024
Big Point Road, Registered Plan H-608, being Part 2 on
Plan 1R-14368, Township of Hilton, District of Algoma.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient and in the interest of the Corporation of the Township of Hilton, hereinafter called the Corporation, that the original shore road allowance described as part of Shore Road Allowance in front of Lot 12, Concession Z, also being in front of Lot 28, municipally known as 4024 Big Point Road, Registered Plan H-608, being Part 2 on Plan 1R-14368, Township of Hilton, District of Algoma, be closed and stopped up and the lands sold to the adjoining landowners;

AND WHEREAS notice of the By-law has been published and distributed in accordance with all applicable legislation;

AND WHEREAS the Council for the said Corporation has heard in person or by his counsel, solicitor or agent, all persons claiming that their land will be prejudicially affected by this By-Law and who applied to be heard;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Hilton hereby enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** upon and after the passing of this By-law all that portion of the shore road allowance lying in front of Lot 12, Concession Z, also being in front of Lot 28, municipally known as 4024 Big Point Road, Registered Plan H-608, Township of Hilton, District of Algoma, more particularly described as Part 2 on Registered Plan 1R-14368, and the same is hereby closed and stopped up.
2. **THAT** all that part of the said unopened shore road allowance herein before described and stopped up shall be sold to the adjoining owner or owners or any of them.
3. **THAT** the Reeve and Clerk of the Corporation of the Township of Hilton are hereby authorized to sign and execute such deeds or other documents as may be necessary to effect conveyance of that part of the said unopened shore road allowance herein before described and which has been stopped up and closed.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed in Open Council this 16th day of September 2026.
