2026 Final Taxes

The 2026 Final Taxes are due Wednesday, September 30th, 2026.

Payments can be made through:

- Cheque
 - Online banking through your financial institution
 - E-transfer to admin@hiltontownship.ca, send a separate email with the security question answer
- Please reference your 19-digit Roll Number with all payment methods, as outlined on the bottom of your tax bill.

Please allow 2 to 5 business days for payment processing.

The final tax bill is calculated using the 2026 returned assessment from MPAC (Municipal Property Assessment Corporation) multiplied by the applicable 2026 tax rate. Please retain your final tax bill for income tax purposes, as it shows the annual taxation amount for the current year.

🔥 Ontario law requires working smoke alarms on every storey of your home and outside all sleeping areas. Make sure your family is protected by testing your alarms regularly and replacing batteries as needed.
